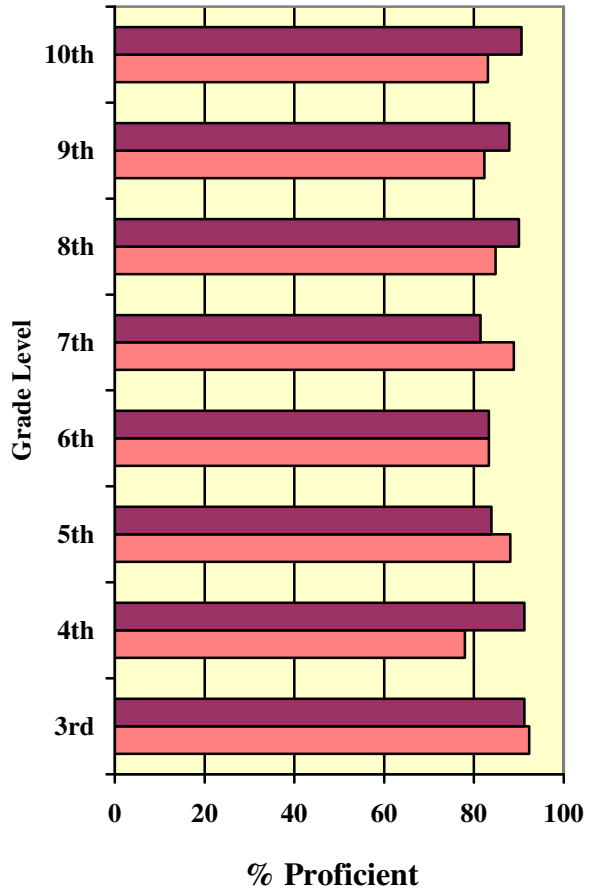

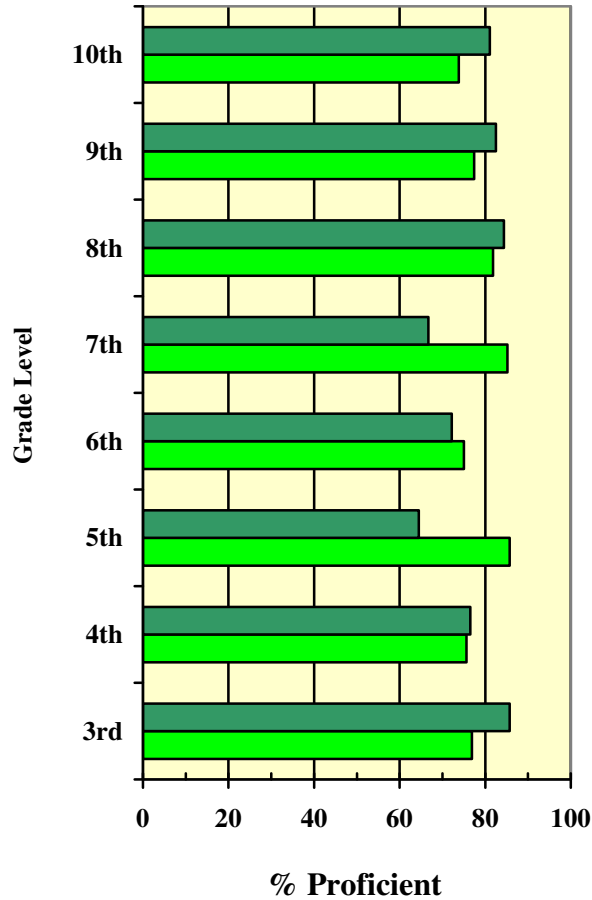
## Two-Year Trend for District Students Scoring Proficient or Above by Grade Level

### READING ASSESSMENTS



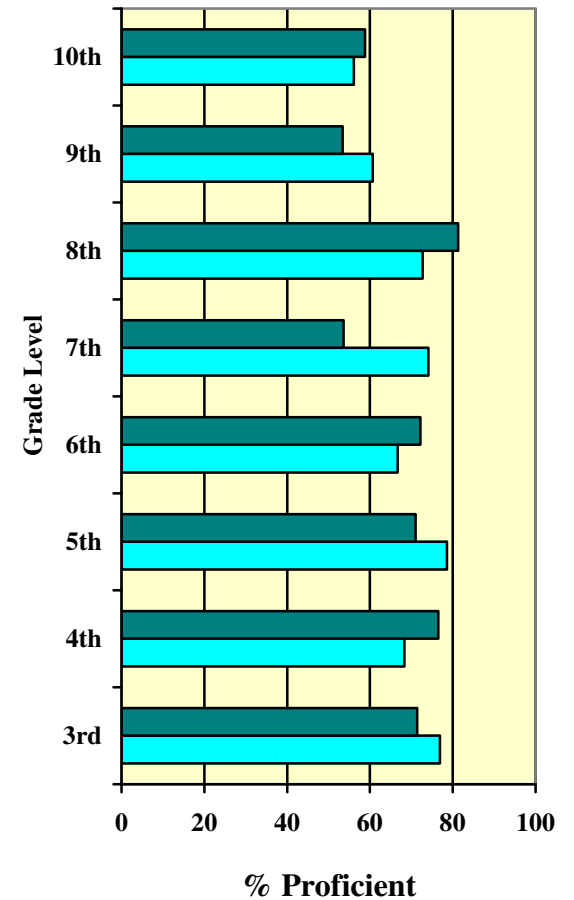
■ Reading 06-07
